Step 2 : First-time Voter Registration VS Registered Voter

Upon receiving your membership from ITFC designated association in STEP ONE, please go to **hk2020.vote** to register your voter eligibility with the Registration and Electoral Office (“REO”).

➤ “First-time voter registration”

1. Go to hk2020.vote
2. Click top right corner “New Voter Reg” > “Traditional Functional Constituencies”
3. Fill out personal information and submit to REO

Deadline for registering voter eligibility with REO is **May 2, 2020**.

➤ “Registered voter”

Registered voter to change respective functional constituency either from Super District or other professional FC to the IT sector.

1. Go to hk2020.vote
2. Click top right corner “Change of Voter Reg Info” > “Report on Change of...Constituency”
3. Follow instructions to fill out the registration form and submit to REO

Deadline for registering voter eligibility with REO is **April 2, 2020**.
